Ground floor flat with access to small garden. Close to schools and main transport links. On a busy main road, so may be noisy.

C

3-bedroom terraced house

Close to local schools and community shopping centre. Three large bedrooms, bathroom and separate toilet, enclosed rear garden.

D

3-bedroom house

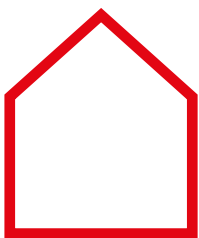
Nice house in a quiet, rural area with storage space. Centrally heated, double glazed.

E

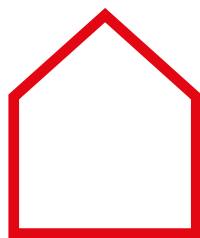
1-bedroom flat

Large 3rd floor flat on the edge of town, walking distance to mainline station. Built-in wardrobes. Separate bathroom. No pets allowed.

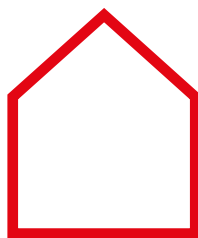

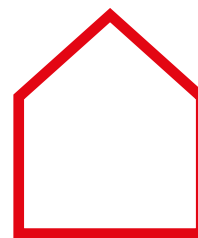

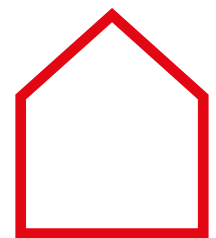
