Housing and homelessness in Scotland



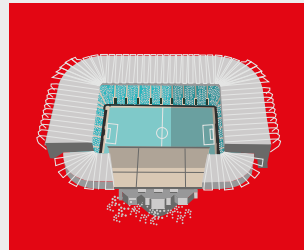
137,100 households are on council waiting lists for a home

That's the same as the entire populations of Inverness and Paisley combined!



6,581 children are in temporary accommodation

That's equivalent to 3 homeless children in every school in Scotland.



67,000 households are overcrowded

That's more than the biggest football stadium in Scotland can hold.



One million people are living in poverty after housing costs

That's one in five people in Scotland.
