Slippers all 'round...
wear them at school, walking to school, at your carol concert, at breakfast, in the bath...the crazier the better! See if you can get at least 50 children, parents and teachers wearing their slippers and donating!

New Year, New You...
50 good deeds around the house! Ask parents to sponsor their children to do 50 helpful things in the month of January and donate a tiny 1p for each good deed they do.

Spring into Action for 50p.
Run up and down your schools' playground 50 times, walk up and down the stairs 50 times, dance for 50 minutes or skip 50 times for Shelter Scotland... anything goes! You could sell 50p tickets to watch or get sponsored by friends and family!

Eggy House Hunting.
Ask the kids to decorate eggs to look like little houses! Then either hold an Easter egg hunt where parents and children pay an entry fee of 50p or £5 to take part or simply get the kids to 'sell' their parents their amazing Eggy House for 50p.

Join the Home Team!
On your Sports Day hold a pupils vs teachers race (and charge 50p each to take part): 50 obstacles...50 push ups...50 star jumps...and 50 laps in 50 minutes! 50/50 Sports Day Raffle: If you don't have the time to plan a separate fundraiser, consider having a 50/50 raffle during scheduled Sports Day, splitting the sales proceeds equally between the school and Shelter Scotland. For example, if you sell £100 worth of raffle tickets, the lucky number holder would get £50 to spend on useful items for his class and Shelter Scotland would get the other £50.

A bit of Home Cooking.
It's time to rustle up some delicious treats to raise money for Shelter Scotland. Ask the kids to bring in their favourite bit of home cooking and sell it at lunchtime, in the playground or after school - people love food!

Home is where the heart is.
Give your pupils paper hearts to take home and, as homework, write a message of support for homeless children and families. Ask them to bring it back to school with a donation of 50p, create a display using the hearts on the wall in your classroom or school's reception. Take a photo and share on social media like @shelterscotland or on the Shelter Scotland Facebook page for everyone to see!
